### **FOR CLASSES 9 & 11.**

### **FOR BOARDERS**

Private Boarders of classes 10 and 12 are to report at Dr. Graham's Homes between the 10th and 12th of November, 2021.

Supported Boarders will be informed about their return travel details by the school.
